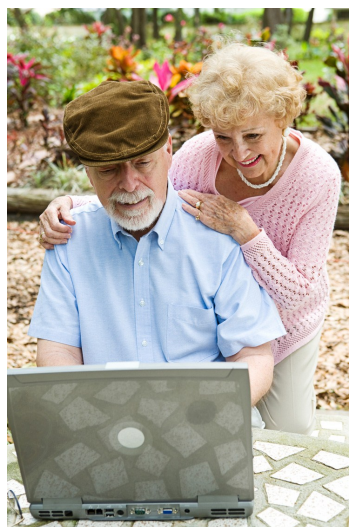

### **Program 1:**

**Computers: An Introduction:** The program presents an overview of laptops & desktops computers using both Windows 8 and the Mac operating systems and offering tips as to the differences between the two systems and what users can do with computers running either operating system right out of the box. If you're interested in buying a new computer this is the workshop for you!

### **Program 2: Skype**

Learn to make video calls with Skype. Skype is a popular platform used to make free video calls from one Internet connected device to another. We'll assist attendees in creating their own Skype account and show them the basic video calling ropes. So if you'd like to video chat with your children or grandchildren this workshop is for you!

### **Program 3: Tablet & E-Readers: An Introduction:**
