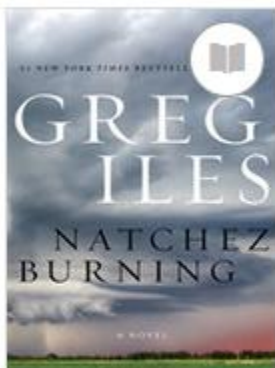
Access to free e-books?

We do!

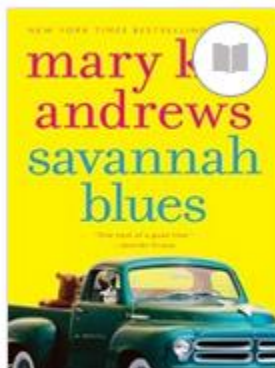
You can download library e-books and read them on your e-reader, or you can download the **OverDrive Media Console** app to your smartphone or tablet and then download them and read them through the app.

The OverDrive app can be found in the Apple, Android & Windows app stores --

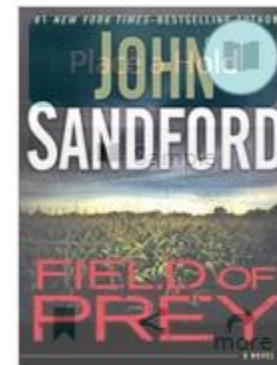

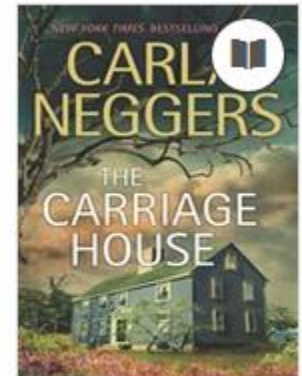

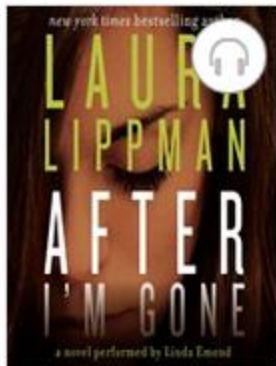

Did you know that your library offers...

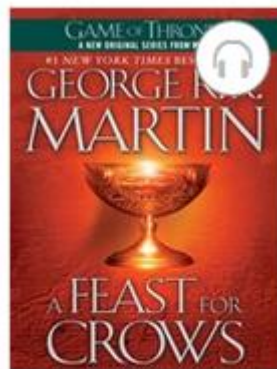
Access to free downloadable audio books?

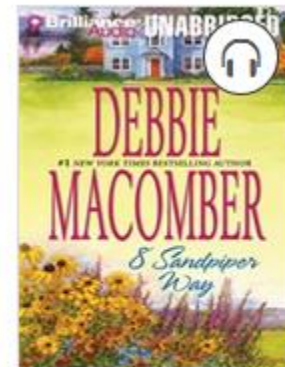

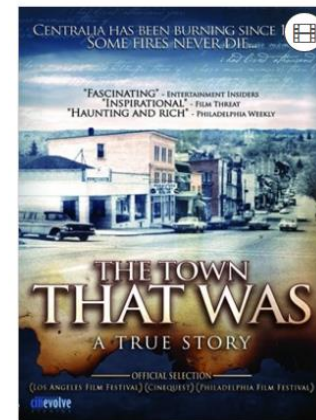
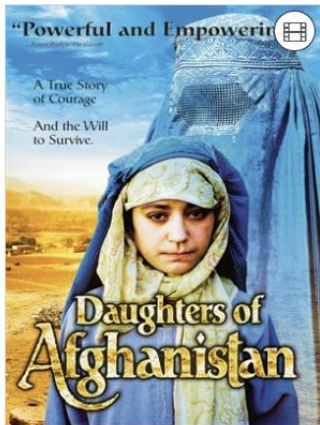

Did you know that your library offers...

Access to a free and growing collection of streaming videos! *We do!*

No software download or app required! Simply go to the library's website found at: SSCLIBRARY.ORG and click on the STLS Digital Catalog link to browse the streaming video titles.

Note: You *can* download the OverDrive app and access the videos through the app if you wish; however, as the videos don't download – you can also stream them from the web – so you don't have to use the app if you don't want to!



Free access to a variety of credible online resources that are available to all library card holders but that cannot be freely accessed over the web...

The databases include:

JobNow!: an online service that offers you assistance in creating a resume or cover letter online and even the option to chat, online, with a resume expert.

Mango Languages: a databases that offers interactive tutorials that give learners the basics gist of how to speak more than 40 languages, including material for ESL learners.

Academic OneFile: a great resource to access to find general information on a whole host of topics!

Health Reference Center: A database that offers information on a wide range of health related topics.

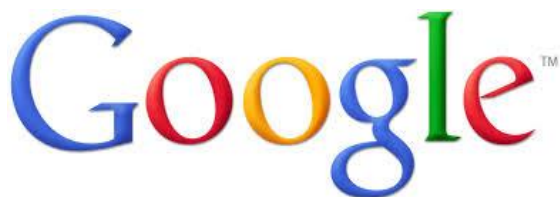
